WESTERN NC NEEDS

Please prayerfully consider traveling to Western North Carolina and helping with the rebuilding of homes for those who lost their homes during hurricane Helene. Teams are desperately needed at the five rebuild sites in Western NC. If only for a weekend, you are needed (experienced or not)! As of August 10th, 433 homes have been completed and 248 are in progress. However, there are still more than 1300 requests. More than half the cost of building is labor, but with volunteers providing the labor, NC Baptists on Mission can double or even triple the number of families that get back into their homes sooner rather than later.
